**Updated Syllabus and Common Course Structure for Open Elective Courses in French, German and Russian languages (CBCS) for the session 2018 onwards.**

**Objectives:**

- Basic knowledge of spoken, written and general comprehension of the language.
- To be able to read and understand elementary texts.
- To have a general idea of the culture and civilization of the country of the language

**Semester I:**

No. of teaching hours = 32

No. of credits = 02

**Course Structure:**

As a matter of policy the institute shall adopt *The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* for teaching purposes.

**Paper I (written)**

- Functional grammar based on the textbook
- Comprehension of simple texts
- Translation of simple passages/simple sentences into English or/and vice versa

**Paper II (Oral)**

- Listening comprehension
- Reading of texts
- General questions

**Scheme of Examinations:**

There will be an Internal Assessment of 10 marks comprising one sessional test. The test will comprise one written and one oral part of equal weightage.

End Semester examination will be of 40 marks of one hour duration of 30 marks for Written and 10 marks for Oral part.

**Note:**

Evaluation and examination of the course shall be conducted internally. Module I of the Prescribed Text-book/ Method of the language (Certificate Course) shall be taught during the course.
